BEAUREGARD ALTERNATIVE PROGRAM HISTORY

Beauregard Alternative Program was created on August 5, 1998, to provide defiant students in Grades 5-12 a strict atmosphere in which to redirect, relearn and rethink.

Beauregard Alternative Program is located at 506 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive in DeRidder, Louisiana and located in the building formerly known as East Side Upper Elementary.

PHILOSOPHY OF BEAUREGARD ALTERNATIVE PROGRAM

The philosophy of the Beauregard Alternative Program is to provide redirection, rethinking and relearning in a strict, regimented atmosphere for students in Grades 5-12. For many students, the Alternative School is the last opportunity to receive a high school diploma or receive credits for the year. Each student will be expected to follow guidelines of the Alternative Program, as well as all parish and state policies. Our three Expectations for Success at BAP are: Attendance, Academics and Behavior.

BEAUREGARD ALTERNATIVE PROGRAM LIMITS

The opportunity for the students to be successful at the alternative program shall have limitations. No student shall be able to enroll at Beauregard Alternative Program more than once per school year. Between grades 5-8, the opportunity to redirect, rethink and relearn, shall be limited to three (3) enrollments at Beauregard Alternative Program. Between grades 9-12, the opportunity to enroll at Beauregard Alternative Program will be limited to two (2) enrollments.

No student can be enrolled at Beauregard Alternative Program more than five (5) times during grades 5-12.
